Festival Points

What are Festival Points and why are they so important to your child?

OBPS students are allocated to a “Colour Group” (Red, Green, Yellow and Blue) in the Infants which transitions to a “House Group” (Sturt, Cook, Phillip and Flinders) (of the same colour) when they progress to the primary school. “House”/ “Colour Group” points are awarded for sporting, academic and behavioural excellence. These points accumulate over the course of the school year. At speech night, the academic, sporting and “overall” house shields are presented to the house/s awarded the most points during the year.

The **Oyster Bay Art and Craft Festival Shield** is a trophy awarded to the “Colour/House Group” awarded the most Festival Points. The trophy is prestigious AND every child in the winning “Colour/House Group” receives a free ice block on the day that the trophy is presented. Festival points are awarded for contributions to the Festival (goods/sponsorship/time/service).
